The Nevada Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (NV POST) mandates 12 hours of annual continuing education for Nevada peace officers due by December 31st. All 12 hours may be taken online.

Required topic categories include:

- Racial profiling
- Mental health, including, without limitation, crisis intervention
- The well-being of officers
- Implicit bias recognition
- De-escalation
- Human trafficking
- Firearms
- Interactions with persons with developmental disabilities
