

NOTE: The New Hampshire Police Standards and Training Council (PSTC) requires certified police, corrections, and probation/parole officers in New Hampshire to complete 24 hours of in-service training due by December 31.

Of the 24 hours, mandated training topics include:

- 2 hours of Implicit Bias and Cultural Response
- 2 hours of Ethics
- 2 Hours of De-escalation

Additional hours are at the discretion of the agency. Local agency training supervisors are responsible for reviewing and selecting courses that will meet PSTC standards and reporting training completions to NH PSTC.

Courses are subject to change as Vector Solutions updates our courses and state legislation changes mandated training requirements.
