State Emergency Management Agencies (EMAs) are challenged to deliver effective disaster preparedness and response while facing more and more historic disasters (hurricanes, wildfires, floods), acts of terrorism, and new threats like health-related pandemics and staffing shortages. As the types and frequency of emergencies continue to change, the importance of leveraging technology to improve preparedness, risk analysis, and planning is amplified.

With such a large and dispersed force of emergency personnel across a state, EMAs must find efficient ways to ensure responders are prepared and qualified for the respective skillsets needed for each type of emergency.

EMAs Track & Support Many Skillsets

EMAs track thousands of personnel certifications, ranging from National Incident Management System (NIMS) courses, specialty skills like HAZMAT and infrastructure management, state-specific programs, and professional certifications like Emergency Management Officers (EMOs).

In addition, many EMAs run state emergency management training academies, provide FEMA courses, and offer professional development series for local emergency managers, nonprofits, and private sector organizations.

Common EMA Challenges

In spite of these increasing challenges, many state EMAs are still reliant on manual tracking methods, spreadsheets, and paper-based processes which significantly hinders state emergency management operations. This results in:



Fragmented and Manual Processes

Small-staffed EMA offices face critical bottlenecks in training coordination and capacity planning.



Limited Real-time Data for Planning

Lack of comprehensive, real-time data inhibits leaders to quickly identify training and resource gaps



Operational Inefficiencies and Administrative Overhead

Outdated and disconnected systems burden personnel with excessive administrative tasks, diverting essential time and effort from mission-critical training and operational readiness.
